As part of an international partnership, WeLOOP is developing an online decision-making tool that helps companies to identify potential supply risks and create stable and sustainable supply chains. The candidate will closely collaborate with the team's scientific expert and web developer and contribute to the development of the tool via the interpretation, collection, and transformation of data from scientific literature, policy reports, and reports of (inter)national organizations, such as the World Bank, United Nations Environmental Program, and geological surveys.

Responsibilities

- Data collection and formatting to feed the decision-making model from scientific and grey literature
- Contribution to the understanding and communication of data gaps, data uncertainty, and data quality
- Contribution to the refinement of the decision-making model that forms the basis of the web-tool
- Formulation of a strategy to allow future maintenance of the tool considering data updates
- Contribution to other ongoing projects and day-to-day business activities of WeLOOP
